FINANCIAL REPORT

Once paid, the balance of available funds will be £6,265.12.

SPORTS ASSOCIATION REPORT

The changing rooms were left in poor order from the Youth Team – Mr Perry has confronted them and asked that the facilities are left in good, clean condition in future.
